Basketball Overview

- We will be having 2 referees for every playoff game (\$45/per school)
- > Both teams must have someone keeping the books during games (Fouls, etc.)
- > Home team must provide a scorekeeper to do the clock
- Running Clock will begin at 20pts for JV and 25pts for Varsity/No press
- PLEASE remember to use appropriate language on and off the court and refrain from showboating and unsportsmanlike conduct at ALL TIMES

Scoring

- Both Schools MUST input records and scores after every game so that we may keep live standings that are up to date. Makes it a lot easier to make playoff schedules and stay updated instead of chasing down schools for records at end of season. Example Below:

League/Trophy Fees

- Teams <u>MUST</u> have rosters with player names and jersey #'s with them at every game to give to other team's coach. If any issues, we can verify with Terrie.

Spring Volleyball/Flag Football
